



## Connect to the **BARON MOBILE LINK VIEWER**

Take full advantage of your Mobile Link system by accessing the full suite of supported XMWX weather products directly from your connected display device.

The Baron Mobile Link Viewer delivers mission-critical weather data through your Mobile Link-connected devices so you can easily display the latest information on turbulence, icing, lightning and more. Follow the instructions below to begin using your Mobile Link Viewer.

- 1** Ensure your device is connected to the “Mobile Link” wireless network.
- 2** Open your preferred browser on your Mobile Link-connected device.
- 3** Enter the following URL: <http://10.1.11.1>
- 4** Save the URL to your home screen for one-tap access.

## General Instructions:

- A** To select a weather product, click the PRODUCTS button in the upper left. Select and overlay different data products by clicking the checkbox next to your desired data product(s).
- B** If you select more than one data product, you can switch between legends by clicking the arrow buttons to the right and left of the legend key.
- C** Control animation with the PLAY, PAUSE and NOW buttons. Use (-) or (+) to control the animation speed.
- D** Click GPS to locate your device on the map.
- E** Select CLEAR to deselect all data products at once. Pressing the CLEAR button will not turn off your GPS locator.
- F** The ECHO TOPS data can be filtered by altitude using the scroll selector below the legend.
- G** TURBULENCE, CURRENT ICING PRODUCT—CIP and SUPERCOOLED LARGE DROPLETS—SLD allow you to select different altitudes with the scroll selector below the legend.
- H** Click individual METARs to decode information on temperature, dew point, wind speed, sky conditions and visibility.
- I** Click specific COUNTY WARNINGS to read issue and expiration times.
- J** AIRMETS, SIGMETs, TFRs and TAFs are all clickable to review data.
